4. Title: Board of Nursing; application for license or certification; military spouse; expedited review.

Summary: Provides that the Board of Nursing shall expedite application processing, to the extent possible, pursuant to § 54.1-119, in which an applicant for licensure or certification is licensed or certified in another state and is relocated to the Commonwealth pursuant to a spouse's official military orders.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill would not have a fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. Boards at the Department of Health Professions are already required to expedite licensure for military spouses by § 54.1-119 of the Code of Virginia.
