The Lottery currently has one part-time investigator who would be covered under the Line of Duty Act (LODA) pursuant to the passage of the proposed legislation. Any additional costs incurred to support the Lottery's part-time investigators would be included in subsequent LODA invoices. The current LODA premium is \$705.77 per employee.
