4. Title: Physician assistants; licensure by endorsement.

5. Summary: Authorizes the Board of Medicine to issue a license by endorsement to an applicant for licensure as a physician assistant who (i) is the spouse of an active duty member of the Armed Forces of the United States or the Commonwealth, (ii) is a graduate of an approved physician assistant education program, and (iii) holds a license as a physician assistant that is in good standing, or that is eligible for reinstatement if lapsed, under the laws of another state, the District of Columbia, or a United States possession or territory.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill would not have a fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. Boards at the Department of Health Professions are already required to issue licensure for military spouses by § 54.1-119 of the Code of Virginia that meet the criteria.
