4. Title: Breach of Procedures related to the Firefighters and Emergency Medical Technicians Procedural Guarantee Act

Summary: The proposed bill provides that any breach of procedure required by the Firefighters and Emergency Medical Technicians Procedural Guarantee Act must not exclude any evidence that is gathered solely through an interrogation that breached such procedures from being presented in any case against a firefighter or individual who meets the definition of emergency medical services personnel.
