4. Title: Issuance of temporary licenses; individuals engaged in counseling residency.

5. Summary: Allows the Board of Counseling to promulgate regulations for the issuance of temporary licenses to individuals engaged in a counseling residency for the purpose of meeting the Board's licensure requirement for postgraduate counseling practice during a supervised residency period.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill would not have a fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. The provisions of the bill would require the Board of Counseling to promulgate regulations, however this will not impact the agency or its operations.
