3. Committee: Passed both Houses.

4. Title: Issuance of temporary licenses; individuals engaged in counseling residency.

5. Summary: Directs the Board of Counseling to promulgate emergency regulations for the issuance of temporary licenses to individuals engaged in a counseling residency so that they may acquire the supervised, postgraduate experience required for licensure.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. No Fiscal Impact.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill would not have a fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. The provisions of the bill would require the Board of Counseling to promulgate regulations, however this will not impact the agency or its operations. Furthermore, the Board currently registers residents and charges a fee for the registration of supervision and for a change in supervision.
