**4. Title:** Department of Motor Vehicle records; certain private vendors; penalty

**5. Summary:** This bill requires the Department of Motor Vehicles to release certain vehicle owner data, upon request, to a private vendor operating a video-monitoring system on or in a school bus. The bill provides for a civil penalty of \$1,000 for disclosure of personal information for other than enforcement purposes.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary. See Item #8

**8. Fiscal Implications:** No state fiscal impact is anticipated from this legislation. The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) is required by law to provide information to government entities and their agents free of charge. Thus, DMV does not make any revenue from providing access to this information. Any fiscal impact on education would be at the local level and would be indeterminate.

**9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** Department of Motor Vehicles, local school divisions.
