4. Title: Hazardous Waste Site Inventory.

5. Summary: Requires the Department of Environmental Quality to compile by July 1, 2020, to update at least annually thereafter, and to post to its website a Hazardous Waste Site Inventory. The Inventory shall be a current listing of sites, not otherwise excluded from regulation as hazardous waste, permitted by or in corrective action under to the Department at which the disposal of hazardous waste has occurred, providing specific information about each site.
