3. Committee: Transportation.

4. Title: Suspension of tolls; evacuations.

5. Summary: Requires the Commissioner of Highways to temporarily suspend toll collection operations in affected evacuation zones and affected areas during any mandatory evacuation. Current law authorizes the Commissioner, in his discretion, to temporarily suspend toll collection operations in cases of emergency and concern for public safety.
