4. Title: Violation of protective order; armed with firearm or other deadly weapon;
penalty.

5. Summary: This bill requires a three-year minimum sentence for violating any provision of a protective order while knowingly armed with a firearm or other deadly weapon.

8. Fiscal Implications: The proposed legislation amends current law (§ 16.1-253.2) relating to protective orders. Under current law, anyone who violates any provision of a protective order while knowingly armed with a firearm or other deadly weapon is guilty of a Class 6 felony.

This bill enhances the punishment by requiring a three-year mandatory minimum sentence for the offense. In addition, the bill requires such minimum sentence to be served consecutively with any other sentence.

According to the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission, the proposal is expected to have an impact on the future state-responsible prison bed space needs of the Commonwealth. Pursuant to §30-19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission estimates a fiscal impact of \$136,078 (the highest annual cost over the next six years). The amount is based on the projection that the legislation will result in 4 additional inmates being incarcerated in prison.

The Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission also estimates a decreased need of less than one local jail bed in the future because offenders would be required to serve state-responsible (prison) sentences.
