3. Committee: Appropriations

4. Title: Teacher licensure; dual enrollment courses; three-year licenses.

5. Summary: Changes the role of the Chancellor of the Virginia Community College System on the Advisory Board on Teacher Education and Licensure from a nonvoting member to a voting member. Requires that the Advisory Board make recommendations relating to licensure qualifications for individuals (i) employed by an institution of higher education to teach career and technical education courses in a high school setting and (ii) to teach dual enrollment courses in a high school setting.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: Any expenses associated with meetings and work conducted by members of the Advisory Board would need to be covered by members' respective agencies. Such costs are indeterminate, but it is expected they could be absorbed.
