5.	<b>Summary:</b> Exempts from licensure any child day program in which child-minding services are offered on site by a small business to no more than five children at any given time, provided that the parent or guardian of every child is an on-duty employee of the small business and can resume responsibility for the child's supervision within 30 minutes upon request.

8.	<b>Fiscal Implications:</b> This legislation adds child-minding services offered on-site by a small business to no more than 5 children at a time to the list of child day program not required to be licensed. It is unknown how many of these programs currently operate in Virginia; however, these programs are exempt from licensure, except if the Commissioner of Social Services receives a complaint about the program. It is assumed that current licensing staff could handle any inspections arising from complaints. This bill does not have a fiscal impact.
