**4. Title:** Firefighting foam management.

**5. Summary:** Effective July 1, 2021, the proposed bill prohibits the discharge or otherwise use of class B firefighting foam that contains intentionally added PFAS chemicals (i) for testing purposes unless otherwise required by law or by the agency having jurisdiction over the testing facility, and with the condition that the testing facility has implemented appropriate containment, treatment, and disposal measures to prevent uncontrolled releases of foam to the environment or (ii) for training purposes, where such foam must be replaced by nonfluorinated training foams.
