8.	Fiscal Implications: This bill would allow Children's Services Act state pool funds set aside for wrap around services to be used in public school settings. Currently, the appropriation act has \$2.2 million per year earmarked for wrap around services provided in non-school settings and localities use about \$1.5 million of that earmark each year. Allowing the funds provided in this earmark to be used in a public school likely would encourage more localities to use these funds, and more of the earmark would be expended on those services. However, because the \$2.2 million per year is already funded, while it may increase the total expenditures up to the cap, there is no need to appropriate additional funds.
