**4. Title:** Compliance with grant requirements; new jobs requirement includes off-site jobs.

**5. Summary:** Specifies that the creation of off-site or teleworking jobs for Virginia residents by a recipient company or its affiliates may be included in assessing compliance with a job-creation requirement for a grant or incentive issued by a state agency.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Final.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This bill would authorize state agencies to include off-site or teleworking jobs as part of the employment goals of their grant and incentive programs. State entities may incur costs in revising the guidelines for their incentive programs that are based on employment goals. However, any such costs are anticipated to be minimal and absorbable within existing resources.
