4. Title: School bus video-monitoring systems; release of information by the Department of Motor Vehicles

5. Summary: This bill authorizes the Department of Motor Vehicles to release vehicle owner data of a vehicle that failed to stop for a stopped school bus upon request of a video-monitoring system operator or upon request of the authorized agent or employee of a video-monitoring system operator.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item #8

8. Fiscal Implications: No state fiscal impact is anticipated from this legislation. The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) is required by law to provide information to government entities and their agents free of charge. Thus, DMV does not make any revenue from providing access to this information. Any fiscal impact on education would be at the local level and would be indeterminate.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Motor Vehicles, local school divisions.

11. Other Comments: This bill is similar to HB 2344, HB 2275, HB 2273, and SB 1520.
