**4. Title:** Department of Motor Vehicles hearings; motor vehicle dealers

**5. Summary:** This bill provides that the Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles shall issue a response to the Motor Vehicle Dealer Board or person reporting an alleged violation and any other party to an investigation, providing an explanation of action taken and the reason for such action.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The fiscal impact of this legislation is indeterminate. The bill requires the Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV), following investigations and hearings on violations, to issue explanatory responses to the Motor Vehicle Dealer Board, persons reporting the alleged violations, and any other parties to the investigations. The volume of how many responses the Commissioner will be required to issue cannot be estimated.
