8.	<b>Fiscal Implications:</b> The proposed legislation requires the Department of Criminal Justice Service (DCJS) to establish certification and recertification training standards for law-enforcement in Advanced Law Enforcement Rapid Response Training and coordinate the delivery of such training.
	DCJS reports that since it remains unknown how many law-enforcement officers will seek certification and subsequent recertification under the proposed legislation, the fiscal impact is indeterminate at this time
