3. Committee: Education

4. Title: Advisory Board on Teacher Education and Licensure; teacher licensure; dual enrollment and career and technical education.

5. Summary: Grants to the Chancellor of the Virginia Community College System voting privileges as a member of the Advisory Board on Teacher Education and Licensure (the Advisory Board). The bill requires the Advisory Board to report to the Board of Education and the Chairmen of the House Committee on Education and the Senate Committee on Education and Health no later than December 1, 2019, recommendations relating to licensure qualifications for individuals (i) employed by an institution of higher education to teach career and technical education courses in a high school setting and (ii) to teach dual enrollment courses in a high school setting.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that state costs resulting from the provisions of this bill can be absorbed by the affected agencies.
