Summary: Provides criteria by which congressional and state legislative districts are to be drawn, including equal population, racial and ethnic fairness, respect for existing political boundaries, contiguity, compactness, and communities of interest. The criteria set out would apply to those districts drawn following the 2020 United States Census and thereafter.

8.	Fiscal Implications: As stand-alone legislation, the Department of Elections considers implementation of this bill as "routine," and does not require additional funding. However, the agency will review all electoral legislation likely to be enacted prior to the passage by each house. If the aggregate number of "routine" bills likely to pass either house is unusually large, it is possible the agency will require additional resources. If so, the Department of Elections will identify the costs at that time.
	Section 24.2-404, Code of Virginia, requires the Department of Elections to provide general registrars voter confirmation documents for newly registered voters and notice to registered voters on changes in their registration records and polling places. The number of voters that may be affected by the standards and criteria for drawing districts pursuant to this bill cannot be determined.
	The proposed legislation is not expected to have a fiscal impact on the Division of Legislative Services.
9.	Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Virginia Department of Elections, Division of Legislative Services, and localities.
