4. Title: Volunteer assistant attorneys for the Commonwealth.

5. Summary: The proposed bill would permit attorneys for the Commonwealth to appoint volunteer assistants in any jurisdiction. Under current law, attorneys for the Commonwealth may only appoint volunteer assistants in cities with a population over 350,000, any city contiguous thereto, and the City of Richmond.
