WHEREAS, after a 1 - 1 first inning, the Chatham Cavaliers pulled ahead with five runs in the second inning and never looked back; and

WHEREAS, senior pitcher Andrew Potojecki shut down the opposing team's hitters, while the Chatham Cavaliers' explosive offense ran rampant, led by Grant Reynolds, Grayson Reed, Matt Arnold, Brae Adkins, and Hunter Adkins; and

WHEREAS, the Chatham Cavaliers' final tally of 23 runs was the most ever in a Virginia High School League state final; the previous record of 22 had stood since 2003; and

WHEREAS, the Chatham Cavaliers' victorious season is a testament to the hard work and determination of all the student-athletes, the leadership of coaches and staff, and the enthusiastic support of the entire Chatham High School community; now, therefore, be it
