Commending the Woodgrove High School girls' soccer team.

WHEREAS, the Woodgrove High School girls' soccer team claimed its third state title in program history with a victory in the Virginia High School League Class 4 state championship in 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Woodgrove High School Wolverines defeated the reigning state champions, the Loudoun County Raiders, by a score of 1 - 0 at Roanoke College; and

WHEREAS, Woodgrove's Liz Marcheschi scored the game-winner off a rebound from a shot by fellow junior Rachel Castro; the tense contest finished in overtime, as did all four of the Woodgrove Wolverines' other matches against the Loudoun County Raiders earlier in the season; and

WHEREAS, the Woodgrove Wolverines' staunch defense, led by center backs Rachel Chatfield and Delaney Boyer and goalkeeper Xanthe Bergel, did not allow a goal during 170 minutes of play in the state semifinal and championship; and

WHEREAS, the Woodgrove Wolverines finished the season with an impressive 20 - 2 - 3 record through the hard work and determination of all the student-athletes, the leadership of coaches and staff, and the passionate support of the entire Woodgrove High School community; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, That the Woodgrove High School girls' soccer team hereby be commended on winning the Virginia High School League Class 4 state championship in 2019; and, be it
