2 An Act to amend and reenact § 2.2-2423 of the Code of Virginia, relating to Virginia Geographic
 3 Information Network Advisory Board; membership.

# 6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

7 1. That § 2.2-2423 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

8 § 2.2-2423. Virginia Geographic Information Network Advisory Board; membership; terms; 9 quorum; compensation and expenses.

A. The Virginia Geographic Information Network Advisory Board (the Board) is hereby established
as an advisory board, within the meaning of § 2.2-2100, in the executive branch of state government.
The Board shall advise the Geographic Information Network Division (the Division) of the Virginia
Information Technologies Agency on issues related to the exercise of the Division's powers and duties.

B. The Board shall consist of 16 18 members appointed as follows: seven nine nonlegislative citizen 14 15 members to be appointed by the Governor that consist of one agency director from one of the natural resources agencies, one official from a baccalaureate public institution of higher education in the 16 17 Commonwealth, one elected official representing a local government in the Commonwealth, one member of the Virginia Association of Surveyors, one representative of a utility or transportation industry 18 19 utilizing geographic data, and two representatives of private businesses with expertise and experience in 20 the establishment, operation, and maintenance of geographic information systems, and two county, city, 21 town, or regional government geographic information system (GIS) directors or managers representing diverse regions of the Commonwealth; four members of the House of Delegates to be appointed by the 22 23 Speaker of the House of Delegates; two members of the Senate to be appointed by the Senate 24 Committee on Rules; the Chief Information Officer, the Commissioner of Highways, and the Chief 25 Executive Officer of the Economic Development Partnership Authority or their designees who shall 26 serve as ex officio, voting members. Gubernatorial appointees may be nonresidents of the 27 Commonwealth. All members of the Board appointed by the Governor shall be confirmed by each house 28 of the General Assembly. The agency director and official from a baccalaureate public institution of 29 higher education in the Commonwealth appointed by the Governor may each designate a member of his 30 organization as an alternate who may attend meetings in his place and be counted as a member of the 31 Board for the purposes of a quorum.

Any members of the Board who are representatives of private businesses that provide geographic
 information services, and their companies, are precluded from contracting to provide goods or services
 to the Division.

35 C. Legislative members' terms shall be coincident with their terms of office. The Following the 36 *initial staggering of terms, the* gubernatorial appointees to the Board shall serve five-year terms, except 37 for the initial appointees whose terms were staggered the two GIS directors or managers, who shall serve two-year terms. Members appointed by the Governor shall serve no more than two consecutive 38 39 five-year terms, except the two GIS directors or managers shall serve no more than two consecutive 40 two-year terms. Vacancies occurring other than by expiration of a term shall be filled for the unexpired 41 term. Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointments. The remainder of any 42 term to which a member is appointed to fill a vacancy shall not constitute a term in determining the 43 member's eligibility to serve.

D. The Board shall elect from its membership a chairman, vice-chairman, and any other officers
deemed necessary. The duties and terms of the officers shall be prescribed by the members. A majority
of the Board shall constitute a quorum. The Board shall meet at least quarterly or at the call of its chairman or the Chief Information Officer.

E. Legislative members of the Board shall receive such compensation as provided in § 30-19.12 and
nonlegislative citizen members shall receive such compensation as provided in § 2.2-2813 for their
services. All members shall be reimbursed for all reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the
performance of their duties as provided in §§ 2.2-2813 and 2.2-2825. Funding for the costs of
compensation and expenses of the members shall be provided by the Virginia Geographic Information
Network Division of the Virginia Information Technologies Agency.

54 F. The Geographic Information Network Division shall provide staff support to the Board.

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
