The Department of Transportation (the Department) shall, in collaboration with the Commonwealth Center for Recurrent Flooding Resiliency, identify public transportation infrastructure in Planning [Districts District] 8 [, 11, and 23] that is at risk of [(i) flooding or (ii)] deterioration 10 11 due to recurrent flooding. For purposes of this section, "public transportation infrastructure" includes 12 roads [, docks, and] bridges [, wharfs, ditches, outfalls, drainage right of ways, and signage]. The 13 Department shall $\begin{bmatrix} (a) \\ (i) \end{bmatrix}$ identify the issues related to recurrent flooding and the scope of such issues 14 15 and $\begin{bmatrix} (b) \\ (ii) \end{bmatrix}$ make policy and budget recommendations to alleviate such issues. The Department shall complete its meetings by November 30, [2020 2021], and the Commissioner shall report its findings 16 and recommendations to the Chairs of the House and Senate Committees on Transportation no later 17 than the first day of the [2021 2022] Regular Session of the General Assembly.
