6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 **1. § 1.** *That the Secretary of Health and Human Resources shall convene a work group to review the*
8 *Commonwealth's medical cannabis program and issues of critical importance to the medical cannabis*
9 *industry and patients, including expansion of the medical cannabis program and the medical use of*
10 *cannabis flowers. Work group members shall include the Secretary of Health and Human Resources, the*
11 *Director of the Department of Health Professions, the executive director of the Board of Pharmacy, one*
12 *member of the House of Delegates, one member of the Senate, three representatives of the medical*
13 *cannabis industry who are currently licensed as pharmaceutical processors by the Board of Pharmacy,*
14 *one person with expertise in issues of importance to patients who use medical cannabis for treatment or*
15 *alleviation of the symptoms of a diagnosed condition or disease, and one member who is a physician*
16 *who is currently registered with Board of Pharmacy to issue written certifications for use of cannabidiol*
17 *oil and THC-A oil. The work group shall report its findings and recommendations, including any*
18 *legislative recommendations, to the Governor, the Attorney General, and the Chairmen of the House*
19 *Committee on Health, Welfare and Institutions and the Senate Committee on Education and Health no*
20 *later than October 1, 2020.*
