10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 63.2-505.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 63.2-505.2. Eligibility for food stamps; drug-related felonies.
13	A person who is otherwise eligible to receive food stamp benefits shall be exempt from the
14	application of section § 115(a) of the <i>federal</i> Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity
15	Reconciliation Act of 1996, P.L. 104-193, and shall not be denied such assistance solely because he has
16	been convicted of a <i>drug-related</i> felony offense of possession of a controlled substance in violation of
17	<u>§ 18.2-250</u> , provided such person is complying with, or has already complied with, all obligations
18	imposed by the criminal court, is actively engaged in or has completed a substance abuse treatment

19 20	program, participates in periodic drug screenings, and any other obligations as determined by the Department.
