11	1. § 1. That the Secretary of Health and Human Resources shall enter into a contract with a qualified
12	entity to study options for financing universal health care in the Commonwealth, including (i) a publicly
13	funded single-payer model administered by the Commonwealth for the delivery of health care that is
14	decoupled from employment, (ii) a publicly funded single-payer model administered by private entities
15	pursuant to a contract with the Commonwealth that is decoupled from employment, (iii) a model that
16	allows residents of the Commonwealth to choose a publicly funded plan administered by the
17	Commonwealth as an alternative to private insurance, and (iv) a model that allows residents of the
18	Commonwealth to choose a publicly funded plan administered by a private entity pursuant to a contract
19	with the Commonwealth as an alternative to private insurance. Such study shall include an analysis of
20	financing mechanisms and costs associated with each model and analysis of legal and logistical barriers
21	to implementation of each model, including identification of any waivers that may be necessary to allow
22	use of federal funds available pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1315 and 42 U.S.C. § 18052 to finance a model
23	administered by the Commonwealth. The Secretary shall report the findings, conclusions, and
24	recommendations of the qualified entity to the Governor and the General Assembly by December 1,
