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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 63.2-1900 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 63.2-1900. Definitions.
13 14	As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning: "Administrative order" or "administrative support order" means a noncourt-ordered legally
14	enforceable support obligation having the force and effect of a support order established by the court.
16	"Assignment of rights" means the legal procedure whereby an individual assigns support rights to the
17	Commonwealth on behalf of a dependent child or spouse and dependent child.
18	"Authorization to seek or enforce a support obligation" means a signed authorization to the
19	Commonwealth to seek or enforce support on behalf of a dependent child or a spouse and dependent
20	child or on behalf of a person deemed to have submitted an application by operation of law.
21	"Cash medical support" means the proportional amount the court or the Department shall order both
22 23	parents to pay toward reasonable and necessary unreimbursed medical or dental expenses pursuant to subsection D of § 20-108.2.
23 24	"Court order" means any judgment or order of any court having jurisdiction to order payment of
25	support or an order of a court of comparable jurisdiction of another state ordering payment of a set or
26	determinable amount of support moneys.
27	"Custodial parent" means the natural or adoptive parent with whom the child resides; a stepparent or
28	other person who has physical custody of the child and with whom the child resides; or a local board
29 30	that has legal custody of a child in foster care.
30 31	"Debt" means the total unpaid support obligation established by court order, administrative process or by the payment of public assistance and owed by a noncustodial parent to either the Commonwealth or
32	to his dependent(s).
33	"Department-sponsored health care coverage" means any health care coverage that the Department
34	may make available through a private contractor for children receiving child support services from the
35	Department.
36	"Dependent child" means any person who meets the eligibility criteria set forth in § 63.2-602, whose
37 38	support rights have been assigned or whose authorization to seek or enforce a support obligation has been given to the Commonwealth and whose support is required by Titles 16.1 and 20.
39	"Electronic means" means service of a required notice by the Department through its secure online
40	child support portal to any person who has agreed to accept service through the portal and has created a
41	user account. The portal shall record and maintain the date and time service is accepted by the user.
42	"Employee" means any individual receiving income.
43	"Employer" means the source of any income.
44 45	"Financial institution" means a depository institution, an institution-affiliated party, any federal credit
45 46	union or state credit union including an institution-affiliated party of such a credit union, and any benefit association, insurance company, safe deposit company, money market mutual fund, or similar entity
47	authorized to do business in this Commonwealth.
48	"Financial records" includes, but is not limited to, records held by employers showing income, profit
49	sharing contributions and benefits paid or payable and records held by financial institutions,
50	broker-dealers and other institutions and entities showing bank accounts, IRA and separate contributions,
51 52	gross winnings, dividends, interest, distributive share, stocks, bonds, agricultural subsidies, royalties,
52 53	prizes and awards held for or due and payable to a responsible person. "Foreign support order" means any order issued outside of the Commonwealth by a court or tribunal
55 54	as defined in § 20-88.32.
55	"Health care coverage" means any plan providing hospital, medical or surgical care coverage for
56	dependent children provided such coverage is available and can be obtained by a parent, parents, or a
57	parent's spouse at a reasonable cost.
58	"Income" means any periodic form of payment due an individual from any source and shall include,

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but not be limited to, income from salaries, wages, commissions, royalties, bonuses, dividends, severance 59

pay, payments pursuant to a pension or retirement program, interest, trust income, annuities, capital 60 61 gains, social security benefits, workers' compensation benefits, unemployment insurance benefits,

62 disability insurance benefits, veterans' benefits, spousal support, net rental income, gifts, prizes or

63 awards.

64 "Mistake of fact" means an error in the identity of the payor or the amount of current support or 65 arrearage.

"Net income" means that income remaining after the following deductions have been taken from 66 gross income: federal income tax, state income tax, federal income compensation act benefits, any union 67 68 dues where collection thereof is required under federal law, and any other amounts required by law.

"Noncustodial parent" means a responsible person who is or may be obligated under Virginia law for 69 70 support of a dependent child or child's caretaker.

Obligee" means (i) an individual to whom a duty of support is or is alleged to be owed or in whose 71 favor a support order has been issued or a judgment determining parentage has been rendered, (ii) a 72 state or political subdivision to which the rights under a duty of support or support order have been 73 74 assigned or that has independent claims based on financial assistance provided to an individual obligee, 75 or (iii) an individual seeking a judgment determining parentage of the individual's child.

76 "Obligor" means an individual, or the estate of a decedent, who (i) owes or is alleged to owe a duty 77 of support, (ii) is alleged but has not been adjudicated to be a parent of a child, or (iii) is liable under a 78 support order. 79

"Payee" means any person to whom spousal or child support is to be paid.

"Reasonable cost" pertaining to health care coverage for dependent children means available, in an amount not to exceed five percent of the parents' combined gross income of the parent responsible for 80 81 providing health care coverage, and accessible through employers, unions or other groups, or 82 Department-sponsored health care coverage, without regard to service delivery mechanism; unless the 83 court deems otherwise in the best interests of the child or by agreement of the parties. 84
