10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 63.2-607.1 as follows:
12	§ 63.2-607.1. Eligibility for TANF; drug-related felonies.
13	A person who is otherwise eligible to receive TANF assistance shall be exempt from the application
14	of § 115(a)(1) of the federal Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996,
15	P.L. 104-193, and shall not be denied such assistance solely because he has been convicted of a felony
16	offense of possession of a controlled substance in violation of § 18.2-250, provided that such person is
17	complying with, or has already complied with, all obligations imposed by the criminal court, is actively
18	engaged in or has completed a substance abuse treatment program, participates in periodic drug

19 screenings, and meets any other obligations as determined by the Department.
