  - Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
- 9 1. That §§ 46.2-862 and 46.2-878.3 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows: 10 § 46.2-862. Exceeding speed limit.

A person shall be is guilty of reckless driving who drives a motor vehicle on the highways in the 11 12 Commonwealth (i) at a speed of twenty 20 miles per hour or more in excess of the applicable maximum speed limit or (ii) in excess of eighty 85 miles per hour regardless of the applicable maximum speed 13 14 limit.

## § 46.2-878.3. Prepayment of fines for violations of speed limits.

15 Except as otherwise provided in this section, the Traffic Infractions and Uniform Fine Schedule 16 adopted by the Supreme Court for prepayment of fines shall, in all instances where prepayment of a fine 17 is permitted, include a fine of \$6 per mile-per-hour in excess of posted speed limits provided for in this 18 article. However, such Traffic Infractions and Uniform Fine Schedule shall include a fine of \$7 per 19 20 mile-per-hour in excess of posted speed limits for a violation of §§ 46.2-873 and 46.2-878.1 and \$8 per mile-per-hour in excess of posted speed limits for a violation of § 46.2-878.2. Any person who drives a 21 motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 80 miles per hour but below [85 86] miles per hour on any 22 23 highway in the Commonwealth having a maximum speed limit of [70 65] miles per hour shall be 24 subject to an additional fine of \$100.
