6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That §§ 46.2-862 and 46.2-878.3 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:**8 **§ 46.2-862. Exceeding speed limit.**

9 A person ~~shall be~~ *is* guilty of reckless driving who drives a motor vehicle on the highways in the
10 Commonwealth (i) at a speed of ~~twenty~~ 20 miles per hour or more in excess of the applicable maximum
11 speed limit or (ii) in excess of ~~eighty~~ 85 miles per hour regardless of the applicable maximum speed
12 limit.

13 **§ 46.2-878.3. Prepayment of fines for violations of speed limits.**

14 Except as otherwise provided in this section, the Traffic Infractions and Uniform Fine Schedule
15 adopted by the Supreme Court for prepayment of fines shall, in all instances where prepayment of a fine
16 is permitted, include a fine of \$6 per mile-per-hour in excess of posted speed limits provided for in this
17 article. However, such Traffic Infractions and Uniform Fine Schedule shall include a fine of \$7 per
18 mile-per-hour in excess of posted speed limits for a violation of §§ 46.2-873 and 46.2-878.1 and \$8 per
19 mile-per-hour in excess of posted speed limits for a violation of § 46.2-878.2. *Any person who drives a*
20 *motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 80 miles per hour but below 86 miles per hour on any highway in*
21 *the Commonwealth having a maximum speed limit of 65 miles per hour shall be subject to an additional*
22 *fine of \$100.*
