10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11 12	1. That § 46.2-1102 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
	§ 46.2-1102. Size and weight limitations inapplicable to farm machinery, agricultural
13 14	multipurpose drying units, and firefighting equipment; amber warning lights. A. Except when restricted by bridge capacity in § 46.2-1104, the vehicle size and weight limitations
14	contained in Articles 14 through 17 (§ 46.2-1101 et seq.) of this chapter shall not apply to (i) any farm
15 16	machinery or agricultural multipurpose drying unit when such farm machinery or agricultural
17	multipurpose drying unit is temporarily propelled, hauled, transported, or moved on the highway by a
18	farm machinery distributor or dealer, fertilizer distributor, or farmer in the ordinary course of business-
19	Nor shall those limitations apply to fire-fighting or (ii) fire-fighting equipment of any county, city, town,
20	or fire-fighting firefighting company or association. Any farm tractor or agricultural multipurpose drying
21	unit wider than 108 inches, however, which is so propelled, hauled, transported, or moved on the
22	highway shall be equipped with a safety light of a type approved by the Superintendent of State Police.
23	The light shall be plainly visible from the rear of the tractor or agricultural multipurpose drying unit.
24	No firefighting equipment of any county, city, or town, or firefighting company or association may be
25	operated on any Interstate Highway System component if it exceeds the weight limitations in
26	§ 46.2-1127.1. No overweight farm machinery or agricultural multipurpose drying unit under this section
27	shall be operated on any Interstate Highway System component if the vehicle has:
28	1. A single axle weight in excess of 20,000 pounds;
29 20	2. A tandem axle weight in excess of 34,000 pounds;
30 21	3. A gross weight, based on axle spacing, greater than that permitted in § 46.2-1126; or
31 32	4. A gross weight, regardless of axle spacing, in excess of 80,000 pounds. B. Notwithstanding subsection A, any farm tractor or other farm, agricultural, or horticultural vehicle
32 33	wider than 108 inches may be equipped with an amber flashing, blinking, or alternating warning light as
34	provided in § 46.2-1025. Any such light may be installed in lieu of or in addition to the safety light
35	described in subsection A. The absence of amber flashing, blinking, or alternating warning lights on any
36	farm tractor or other farm, agricultural, or horticultural vehicle, as authorized under this subsection, shall
37	not constitute negligence, be considered in mitigation of damages of whatever nature, be admissible in
38	evidence or be the subject of comment by counsel in any action for the recovery of damages arising out
39	of the operation, ownership, or maintenance of any motor vehicle or farm tractor, nor shall anything in
40	this section change any existing law, rule, or procedure pertaining to any such civil action.
