10	members of which have made, and continue to make, significant contributions to all facets of the
11	Commonwealth's economic prosperity and overall quality of life; and
12	WHEREAS, Indian traditions, including [ the arts, dance singing, the performing arts ], and cuisine,
13	are an important part of the rich cultural tapestry that make Virginia a special place to live and visit;
14	and
15	WHEREAS, India is a major trading partner with the United States and enjoys a special relationship
16	with Virginia as one of its strongest trade allies; and
17	WHEREAS, August is a special month for Indians around the world, as [ the Republic of ] India
18	celebrates its National Independence Day on August 15; and
19	WHEREAS, India is now the world's most populous representative democracy, [ with great religious
20	and linguistic diversity, ] and Indians are proud to have gained their independence through nonviolence,
21	setting an example for other nations to follow; and
22	WHEREAS, establishing August as Indian [ American ] Heritage Month provides an opportunity to
23	celebrate the cultural, academic, economic, and political contributions of Indian Americans to Virginia
24	and the United States and to teach future generations about the unique heritage and vibrant traditions of
25	India; now, therefore, be it
26	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly designate
27	August, in 2020 and in each succeeding year, as Indian [ American ] Heritage Month in Virginia; and,

29	RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates transmit a copy of this resolution

to Harsh Vardhan Shringla, the Ambassador of India to the United States, so that he may be apprised of 30 31
