WHEREAS, Burke United Methodist Church moved to a new location in 1979 and has continued togrow for the past 40 years; and

WHEREAS, the congregation is currently led by Senior Pastor Jason Snow and Associate Pastor
 Katie Carson-Phillips, who inspire the members of Burke United Methodist Church with their insightful
 sermons; and

18 WHEREAS, in addition to weekly services, Burke United Methodist Church offers infant and
 19 preschool ministries, Sunday school, youth ministry, and small Bible study groups for adults,
 20 encouraging a life of faith and service; and
