WHEREAS, in 2020, Edwin L. Allen, Jr., retires as the chief of the Fredericksburg Fire Department with more than 45 years of diligent service as a public safety officer; and

8 WHEREAS, Edwin Allen fulfilled his childhood dream to serve the community as a firefighter when 9 he joined the Fredericksburg Fire Department in 1974; and

10 WHEREAS, over the course of his career, Edwin Allen witnessed significant changes, both in the 11 needs of the community and in firefighting procedures; he helped the department transition into an 12 all-hazards department that responds to medical emergencies and other crisis situations, as well as fires; 13 and

WHEREAS, during his 16-year tenure as chief, Edwin Allen worked to ensure that the firefighters
under his command had the best tools, techniques, and training to achieve their mission and that the
department was prepared to coordinate emergency management for the city when called upon; and

17 WHEREAS, under Edwin Allen's leadership, the Fredericksburg Fire Department has provided
 18 exceptional, specialized service through its emergency medical services team, confined space rescue and
 19 hazardous materials response team, and diving and underwater rescue team; and

20 WHEREAS, Edwin Allen leaves the Fredericksburg Fire Department well-poised to continue
 21 safeguarding the lives and property of community members; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby
 commend Edwin L. Allen, Jr., on the occasion of his retirement as chief of the Fredericksburg Fire
 Department; and, be it

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution
 for presentation to Edwin L. Allen, Jr., as an expression of the General Assembly's admiration for his
 outstanding service to the Fredericksburg community.
