In conducting its study, the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission shall analyze the 21 relationship between (i) salaries and benefits provided to teachers in the Commonwealth, states adjoining 22 23 the Commonwealth, and the District of Columbia and (ii) the recruitment and retention of teachers in 24

25 Technical assistance shall be provided to the Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission by all local school divisions and the Department of Education. All agencies of the Commonwealth shall 26 27

28 The Joint Legislative Audit and Review Commission shall complete its meetings by November 30, 29 2020, and the chairman shall submit to the Division of Legislative Automated Systems an executive 30 summary of its findings and recommendations no later than the first day of the 2021 Regular Session of
