9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 31 32 33 435 36 37 38 39	WHEREAS, the Office of Drinking Water of the Department of Health is responsible for protecting the public health by ensuring that all people in the Commonwealth have access to an adequate supply of clean, safe drinking water that meets federal and state drinking water standards; and WHEREAS, the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations and state Public Water Supplies Law (§ 32.1-167 et seq. of the Code of Virginia) and state regulations governing waterworks and waterworks operators set out standards for drinking water quality, drinking water infrastructure, and oversight of the drinking water program; and WHEREAS, problems or issues with the existing drinking water infrastructure or oversight of the drinking water program may result in an increased risk of contamination of drinking water with lead, copper, and other substances or organisms; and WHEREAS, contamination of drinking water may have serious negative effects on the health and well-being of residents of the Commonwealth; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Office of Drinking Water of the Department of Health be requested to study the Commonwealth's drinking water infrastructure and oversight of the drinking water program.
