o 9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 55.1-1202 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 55.1-1202. Notice.
12	A. If the rental agreement so provides, the landlord and tenant may send notices in electronic form;
13	however, any tenant who so requests may elect to send and receive notices in paper form. If electronic
14	delivery is used, the sender shall retain sufficient proof of the electronic delivery, which may be an
15	electronic receipt of delivery, a confirmation that the notice was sent by facsimile, or a certificate of
16	service prepared by the sender confirming the electronic delivery.
17	B. In the case of the landlord, notice is served on the landlord at his place of business where the
18 19	rental agreement was made or at any place held out by the landlord as the place for receipt of the communication.
19 20	In the case of the tenant, notice is served at the tenant's last known place of residence, which may be

22	C. Notice, knowledge, or a notice or notification received by an organization is effective for a
23	particular transaction from the time it is brought to the attention of the person conducting that
24	transaction, or from the time it would have been brought to his attention if the organization had
25	exercised reasonable diligence.
26	D. No notice of termination of tenancy served upon a tenant [by a public housing authority
27	organized under the Housing Authorities Law (§ 36-1 et seq.)] [by a public housing authority
28 29	organized under the Housing Authorities Law (§ 36-1 et seq.)] shall be effective unless it contains on its first page, in type no smaller or less legible than that otherwise used in the body of the notice, the
30	name, address, and telephone number of the legal services program, if any, serving the jurisdiction in
30 31	which the premises is located.
32	E. [No notice of termination served by a private landlord upon a tenant receiving tenant-based
33	rental assistance through (i) the Housing Choice Voucher Program, 42 U.S.C. § 1437f(o), or (ii) any
34	other federal, state, or local program shall be effective unless it contains on its first page, in type no
35	smaller or less legible than that otherwise used in the body of the notice, the statewide legal aid
36	telephone number and the statewide legal aid website address.
37	F.] The landlord may, in accordance with a written agreement, delegate to a managing agent or
38	other third party the responsibility of providing any written notice under this chapter. The landlord may
39 40	also engage an attorney at law to prepare or provide any written notice under this chapter or legal process under Title 8.01. Nothing herein shall be construed to preclude use of an electronic signature as
40 41	defined in § 59.1-480, or an electronic notarization as defined in § 47.1-2, in any written notice under
