7 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**8 **1. That § 23.1-3112 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**9 **§ 23.1-3112. Board of directors.**

10 A. New College shall be governed by a ~~12-member~~ 15-member board of directors (the board) that
11 shall consist of five legislative members and ~~seven~~ 10 nonlegislative citizen members. Members shall be
12 appointed as follows: three members of the House of Delegates, to be appointed by the Speaker of the
13 House of Delegates in accordance with the rules of proportional representation contained in the Rules of
14 the House of Delegates; two members of the Senate, to be appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules;
15 and ~~seven~~ 10 nonlegislative citizen members, *three of whom shall be representatives of business and*
16 *industry from the Commonwealth*, to be appointed by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the
17 General Assembly. At least ~~10~~ 13 members shall be residents of the Commonwealth.

18 Legislative members shall serve terms coincident with their terms of office.

19 B. Nonlegislative citizen members shall be appointed for terms of four years. Appointments to fill
20 vacancies, other than by expiration of a term, shall be for the unexpired terms. Vacancies shall be filled
21 in the same manner as the original appointments. All members may be reappointed.

22 No nonlegislative citizen member is eligible to serve more than two consecutive four-year terms;
23 however, a member appointed to serve an unexpired term is eligible to serve two consecutive four-year
24 terms immediately succeeding such unexpired term.

25 C. The board shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman from among its membership and may
26 establish bylaws as necessary. The meetings of the board shall be held at the call of the chairman or
27 whenever the majority of the members so request.

28 D. Nonlegislative citizen members are not entitled to compensation for their services. Legislative
29 members of the board shall be compensated as provided in § 30-19.12. All members shall be reimbursed
30 for all reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties in the work of
31 New College as provided in §§ 2.2-2813 and 2.2-2825. The funding for the costs of compensation and
32 expenses of the members shall be provided by New College.
