10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 20-124.6 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 20-124.6. Access to minor's records.
13	A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, neither parent, regardless of whether such parent has
14	custody, shall be denied access to the academic, <i>child-care</i> , or health records of that parent's minor child
15	unless otherwise ordered by the court for good cause shown or pursuant to subsection B.
16	B. In the case of health records, access may also be denied if the minor's treating physician or the
17	minor's treating clinical psychologist has made a part of the minor's record a written statement that, in
18	the exercise of his professional judgment, the furnishing to or review by the requesting parent of such
19	health records would be reasonably likely to cause substantial harm to the minor or another person. If a
20	health care entity denies a parental request for access to, or copies of, a minor's health record, the health care entity denying the request shall example with the provisions of subsection $E$ of § 22.1.127.102. The
21	care entity denying the request shall comply with the provisions of subsection F of § 32.1-127.1:03. The
22	minor or his parent, either or both, shall have the right to have the denial reviewed as specified in subsection $E$ of $S = 22 + 127 + 102$ to determine whether to make the minor's health record queilable to the
23	subsection F of § 32.1-127.1:03 to determine whether to make the minor's health record available to the
24	requesting parent.

C. For the purposes of this section, the meaning of the term "health record" or the plural thereof and
the term "health care entity" shall be as defined in subsection B of § 32.1-127.1:03.

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
