10	1. § 1. The Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, in consultation with the Department of
11	<i>Environmental Quality and stakeholders, including representatives from grocery stores, food banks,</i>
12	restaurants, and relevant government or academic experts, shall study the sources, scale, and prevention
13	of food waste in the Commonwealth. In conducting its study, the Department of Agriculture and
14	Consumer Services shall (i) assess the total annual statewide rate of preventable food waste received by
15	landfills within the Commonwealth; (ii) identify the industry sectors within the Commonwealth that
16	contribute to preventable food waste, and determine their rate of contribution to such waste; (iii)
17	identify alternative uses of food that is wasted; and (iv) recommend policies to reduce the annual rate of
1/	identify ditermative uses of food that is wasted, and (iv) recommend policies to reduce the annual rate of

preventable food waste in the Commonwealth with data-driven reduction targets and timelines, including
food donation requirements for certain food waste from grocery stores and restaurants.
