3	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 37.2-310.1, relating to the
4	Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services; opioid addiction treatment pilot

10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 37.2-310.1 as follows:
12	§ 37.2-310.1. Opioid addiction treatment and recovery services; pilot program.
13	A. The Department, in partnership with community services boards, a hospital licensed in the
14	Commonwealth, and telemedicine networks, including the Center for Telehealth at the University of
15	Virginia and the Virginia Telemedicine Network, shall establish a two-year pilot program designed to
16	provide comprehensive treatment and recovery services to uninsured or underinsured individuals
17 18	suffering from opioid addiction or opioid-related disorders. The Department, together with the partnering hospital, community services boards, and telemedicine networks shall develop an
10 19	evidence-based treatment and recovery program that may include withdrawal management,
20	medication-assisted treatment, behavioral and cognitive interventions, housing assistance, transportation
21	assistance, and other community supports. The Department shall establish the pilot program in Planning
22	District 12 to serve an area of the Commonwealth where the opioid consumption in milligrams per
23	capita is among the highest in the nation.
24	B. In developing the pilot program, the Department and the partnering hospital, community services
25	boards, and telemedicine networks shall (i) collaborate with and receive recommendations from the
26	work group established pursuant to subsection C and (ii) implement a measurement-based systematic
27 28	substance abuse use disorder monitoring and retention system to track patient outcomes throughout treatment and recovery.
20 29	C. The Department shall establish a work group of interested stakeholders to collaborate with the
<b>3</b> 0	Department in the development of the pilot program. The work group shall include representatives from
31	the [ Department of Medical Assistance Services, the ] Virginia Association of Medication Assisted
32	Recovery Programs, the Virginia Chapter of the American Society of Addiction Medicine, the Virginia
33	Community Healthcare Association, the Virginia Academy of Family Physicians, the Virginia Section of
34	the American Congress of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, the Virginia Council of Nurse Practitioners,
35	the Virginia Chapter of the American College of Physicians, the Virginia Chapter of the American
36	Academy of Pediatrics, the Medical Society of Virginia, the Virginia Association of Community Services
37 38	Boards, and the Virginia Hospital and Healthcare Association. D. The funds available to implement the provisions of this section, as set out in the general
39	appropriation act, shall consist of (i) funds appropriated for such purpose; (ii) notwithstanding the
40	provisions of Chapter 31 (§ 3.2-3100 et seq.) of Title 3.2, payments from the Tobacco Indemnification
41	and Community Revitalization Fund; and (iii) reimbursement received for services provided through the
42	program from coverages issued pursuant to Title XVIII of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. § 1395 et
43	seq. (Medicare).
44	E. The Department shall report the results of the pilot program, including nonidentifiable, aggregate
45 46	data on patient outcomes and any findings or recommendations, to the Board and to the General
46 47	Assembly by December 1, [2020] [2021]. [2. That the provisions of this act shall not become effective unless an appropriation effectuating
<b>4</b> 8	the purposes of this act is included in a general appropriation act passed in 2020 by the General
49	Assembly that becomes law. ]
