11	1. That § 53.1-165.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 53.1-165.1. Limitation on the application of parole statutes.
13	A. The provisions of this article, except §§ 53.1-160 and 53.1-160.1, shall not apply to any sentence
14	imposed or to any prisoner incarcerated upon a conviction for a felony offense committed on or after
15	January 1, 1995. Any person sentenced to a term of incarceration for a felony offense committed on or
16	after January 1, 1995, shall not be eligible for parole upon that offense.
17	B. The provisions of this article shall apply to any person who was sentenced by a jury prior to June
18	9, 2000, for a noncapital felony offense committed on or after January 1, 1995, where the jury was not
19	instructed on the abolition of parole in the Commonwealth, and who remained incarcerated for such
20	offense on July 1, 2020.
21	C. The Parole Board shall establish procedures for consideration of parole of persons entitled under
22	subsection B consistent with the provisions of § 53.1-154 allowing for extension of time for reasonable

cause.

23 24 D. Any person entitled under subsection B for consideration of parole shall be given priority for consideration of parole over all other eligible persons. Such persons entitled under subsection B shall have a parole hearing no later than July 1, 2021. 25 26
