A BILL to direct the Library of Virginia to standardize retention schedules for regulatory boards with
respect to unfounded complaints.
Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
1. § 1. That the Library of Virginia is directed to standardize its various retention schedules for boards
that regulate professions and occupations to allow confidential destruction of records related to (i)
complaints or claim files that have been closed due to an incomplete or withdrawn complaint,
insufficient evidence, or an inapplicable board regulation and (ii) investigations into possible violations
of laws or regulations that do not result in disciplinary action by the board, including complaints or

action taken on such complaints, claims, or investigations.
