Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 8 1. § 1. The Department of Education shall develop and adopt a common statewide definition for the 9 term "students with limited or interrupted formal education" and shall require local school divisions to 10 report the number of students who fall under such definition as part of the required data collection and 11 reporting on average daily membership for the purposes of documenting any changes in such numbers 12 13 over time. 14 § 2. The Board of Education shall evaluate the supports and programs available to "students with 15 limited or interrupted formal education" in local school divisions to determine whether the calculations 16 for the school quality indicators within the Board's Regulations Establishing the Standards for 17 Accrediting Public Schools in Virginia (8VAC20-131-5 et seq.) are appropriate or whether changes in methodology could be made to more comprehensively measure the academic and nonacademic 18 achievement of such student population. Such evaluation shall be completed to make the necessary 19 20 revisions to impact the methodology for the calculation of school accreditation ratings for the

21 2021-2022 school year.
