## VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

Tourism Authority; Governor's New Airline Service Incentive Fund.

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## Approved

### Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6

#### 7 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 2.2-2320.1 as follows: 8 § 2.2-2320.1. Governor's New Airline Service Incentive Fund.

9 A. There is hereby created in the state treasury a special nonreverting fund known as the Governor's 10 New Airline Service Incentive Fund, referred to in this section as "the Fund." The Fund shall be established on the books of the Comptroller. All funds appropriated for such purpose and any gifts, 11 12 donations, grants, bequests, and other funds received on its behalf shall be paid into the state treasury 13 and credited to the Fund. Interest earned on moneys in the Fund shall remain in the Fund and be credited to it. Any moneys remaining in the Fund, including interest thereon, at the end of a biennium 14 15 shall not revert to the general fund but shall remain in the Fund. Moneys in the Fund shall be used, in the sole discretion of the Governor, for grants to airlines serving local, regional, national, and 16 17 international airports in Virginia as provided in subsection B. Revenues in the Fund shall be used to 18 support the development of additional commercial air services in the Commonwealth, provided that such 19 service advances the goals established in the commercial air service plan most recently adopted 20 pursuant to § 5.1-2.2:2. Expenditures and disbursements from the Fund shall be made by the State 21 Treasurer on warrants issued by the Comptroller upon written request signed by the Executive Director 22 of the Authority.

23 B. The Fund shall be used by the Governor to provide or assist in the provision of marketing, 24 advertising, or promotional activities by airlines in connection with the launch of new air passenger 25 service at Virginia airports in order to incentivize airlines that have committed to commencing new air 26 passenger service in Virginia. The Secretary of Transportation, in consultation with the Secretary of 27 Commerce and Trade and the Secretary of Finance, shall develop guidelines and criteria to be used in 28 awarding grants from the Fund. The guidelines shall include a provision that a grant from the Fund 29 shall not be awarded if it can be reasonably anticipated to result in the reduction of existing 30 commercial air service at another airport located within the Commonwealth. The guidelines may require 31 that as a condition of receiving any grant from the Fund an airline enter into a performance agreement 32 or memorandum of understanding with the Commonwealth (i) setting a minimum number of nonstop 33 roundtrip flights per week, a minimum number of nonstop roundtrip flights within 12 months of the start 34 date of new air service, or a minimum passenger load factor, or any combination thereof, and (ii) providing that any grant received by an airline shall be repaid by the airline or reduced proportionately 35 36 if such conditions are not met.
