11	WHEREAS, Carilion Clinic is a not-for-profit health care organization with more than 75 specialties
12	based in Roanoke, Virginia, and serves residents in western Virginia; and
13	WHEREAS, Carilion Clinic and Radford University planned and executed acquisition of Jefferson
14	College of Health Sciences by Radford University in 2018-2019, culminating in recognition in the Code
15	of Virginia pursuant to Chapters 60 and 64 of Acts of Assembly of 2019; and
16	WHEREAS, Carilion Clinic and Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University planned and
17	executed a public-private partnership to form the Virginia Tech Carilion School of Medicine in 2007,
18 19	and the Virginia Tech Carilion School of Medicine officially became a college of Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University in 2018; and
20	WHEREAS, the establishment of the Virginia Tech Carilion School of Medicine has not yet been
2 0 2 1	formally recognized by the General Assembly in the Code of Virginia; and
22	WHEREAS, the University of Virginia Medical Center and the Virginia Commonwealth University
23	Health System Authority are established as teaching hospitals in the Code of Virginia; and
24	WHEREAS, it is imperative to study how the Virginia Tech Carilion School of Medicine should be
25	established as a teaching hospital in the Code of Virginia; now, therefore, be it
26	RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That Virginia Polytechnic Institute
27	and State University be requested to study the requirements for the Virginia Tech Carilion School of
28	Medicine to be designated as a teaching hospital in the Code of Virginia.
29 30	In conducting its study, Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University shall determine (i) the requirements for Virginia Tech Carilion School of Medicine to be designated as a teaching hospital in
30 31	the Code of Virginia, and (ii) how Virginia Tech Carilion School of Medicine will be designated as a
32	teaching hospital in the Code of Virginia.
33	All agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide assistance to Virginia Polytechnic Institute and
34	State University for this study, upon request.
35	Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University shall complete its meetings by November 30,
36	2020, and shall submit to the Governor and the General Assembly an executive summary and a report
37	of its findings and recommendations for publication as a House or Senate document. The executive
38	summary and report shall be submitted as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative
39 40	Automated Systems for the processing of legislative documents and reports no later than the first day of the 2021 Regular Session of the General Assembly and shall be posted on the General Assembly's
