10	WHEDEAS arouted by the Virginia Congred Assembly in 1058 the Ispactown Foundation new the
10	WHEREAS, created by the Virginia General Assembly in 1958, the Jamestown Foundation, now the Jamestown-Yorktown Foundation, is charged by the Code of Virginia with doing "all things necessary
12	and proper to foster through its living-history museums, Jamestown Settlement and the American
12	Revolution Museum at Yorktown, an awareness and understanding of the early history, settlement, and
13 14	development of the United States through the convergence of American Indian, European, and African
14	cultures and the enduring legacies bequeathed to the nation; commemorate the winning of American
15 16	independence on the battlefield at Yorktown; and enhance our understanding of the making of the
17	United States Constitution and Bill of Rights, including the Commonwealth's role in shaping the
18	fundamental principles of the American constitutional system"; and
19	WHEREAS, the American Revolutionary War occurred between 1775 and 1783, when the patriots in
20	the 13 original colonies in North America, with the assistance of France, won independence from Great
20 21	Britain and established the United States of America; and
22	WHEREAS, the 250th anniversary of the quest for American independence is imminent, with
23	significant dates to be commemorated in the coming years, such as April 19, 2025, the 250th
24	anniversary of the outbreak of the American Revolutionary War, with the first shots fired at Lexington
25	and Concord, Massachusetts; October 19, 2031, signifying the 250th anniversary of the surrender of
26	British Lord Cornwallis to General George Washington at Yorktown, Virginia, which effectively ended
27	the war for independence; and September 3, 2033, marking the anniversary of the signing of the Treaty
28	of Paris, officially ending the American Revolutionary War; and
29	WHEREAS, the Yorktown Victory Center, the forerunner to the American Revolution Museum at
30	Yorktown, a world-class museum chronicling the story of the entire scope of the American Revolution,
31	administered by the Jamestown-Yorktown Foundation and officially opened on April 1, 2017, was one
32	of only three centers built in the Commonwealth to help commemorate the nation's bicentennial in 1976;
33	the center played an integral role in the 1981 commemoration of the 200th anniversary of the surrender
34	at Yorktown and was transformed into a museum of the American Revolution; and
35	WHEREAS, since its creation, the Jamestown-Yorktown Foundation has played a fundamental and
36	vital role in assisting with special commemorations, including the 375th anniversary of the first
37	legislative assembly in 1994; the 2007 quadricentennial of the founding of Jamestown through America's
38	400th Anniversary, 1607-2007; and the 400th anniversary of landmark events in Virginia's and the
39	nation's history through American Evolution: Virginia to America, 1619-2019; and
40	WHEREAS, the Commonwealth has established under the Jamestown-Yorktown Foundation a
41	subagency, Jamestown-Yorktown Commemorations, designated to support commemorations of such
42	historic significance; now, therefore, be it
43	RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the Virginia General Assembly
44	designate the Jamestown-Yorktown Foundation as the official executive branch agency to assist the
45 46	Commonwealth in establishing planning systems for commemorating the 250th anniversary of the American Pavolution and the independence of the United States of American and he it
46 47	American Revolution and the independence of the United States of America; and, be it RESOLVED FURTHER, That all agencies of the Commonwealth be authorized, consistent with the
47 48	mission of the agency, to provide assistance and advice to the Jamestown-Yorktown Foundation in

50	anniversary of the American Revolution and that the various agencies and institutions of the
50 51	Commonwealth, upon request of the Foundation and approval of the respective agency head, designate a
51 52	liaison to coordinate assistance and services to the Foundation from their agencies and institutions.
