**4. Title: Virginia Geographic Information Network.**

**5. Summary:** Transfers the support and administration of the 9-1-1 Services Board and Virginia Geographic Information Network Advisory Board from the Virginia Information Technologies Agency to the Virginia Department of Emergency Management. The bill also adds the State Coordinator of Emergency Management to the Virginia Geographic Information Network Advisory Board.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The fiscal impact of this bill would be net neutral for the state. However, this bill would require a budget amendment to transfer appropriation and authorized positions from the Virginia Information Technologies Agency (VITA) to the Virginia Department of Emergency Management (VDEM). The house has included a budget amendment to transfer the resources between agencies in HB30.
